



Ontario Electricity Rebate Self-Declaration Form

Effective **November 1, 2019**, the Ontario government introduced the new Ontario Electricity Rebate, under the Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016.



To be eligible to receive the new Ontario Electricity Rebate (OER) your account must meet at least one of the eligibility criteria noted below.

Please complete and submit the following Ontario Electricity Rebate Self-Declaration Form to Hydro Ottawa before January 31, 2020, in order to avoid a disruption in the receipt of your rebate.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE ONTARIO ELECTRICITY REBATE

DOES YOUR ACCOUNT QUALIFY?

Please check all that apply to the account:

The consumer carries on a business that is a farming business for the purposes of the Farm Registration and Farm Organizations Funding Act, 1993, and holds a valid registration number assigned under that Act or has had their obligation to file a farming business registration form waived pursuant to an order made under subsection 22 (6) of that Act.

The account is in respect of a long-term care home licensed under the Long-Term Care Homes Act, 2007, other than an account that is also in respect of a hospital as defined in the Broader Public Sector Accountability Act, 2010.

The account is solely in respect of a multi-unit complex, but is not an account referred to above and all of the following conditions are met:

- (i) The account has (a) a demand for electricity greater than 50 kilowatts and (b) annual electricity consumption greater than 250,000 kilowatt hours.
- (ii) The multi-unit complex contains at least two units (qualifying units*) that consist of a self-contained room or set of rooms, contain kitchen and bathroom facilities that are for the sole use or intended use of the unit, and are occupied and used as a residence.
- (iii) At least 50 percent of the units within the multi-unit complex are qualifying units as described in the sentence above.

*A qualifying unit means a unit that, (a) consists of a self-contained room or set of rooms, (b) contains kitchen and bathroom facilities that are for the sole use of the unit, and (c) is occupied and used as a residence. The complex must contain at least two (2) qualifying units AND the number of qualifying units must equal at least 50% of the total number of units within the complex.

PREVIOUSLY ELIGIBLE ACCOUNTS - TRANSITION PERIOD

Important Note: As part of this rebate program, there will be a period of transition for consumer accounts which do not meet the eligibility criteria listed on page 1, but were previously receiving a reduction on their bill pursuant to the *Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016*, on October 22, 2019.

Previously eligible accounts, which are categorized below, will receive the Ontario Electricity Rebate through **April 30, 2021**, as long as this form is received by Hydro Ottawa by **January 31, 2020**. If this form is <u>not</u> received by January 31, 2020, these accounts will no longer receive the Ontario Electricity Rebate as of **February 1, 2020**.
