

# Ontario's System-Wide Electricity Supply Mix: 2020 Data

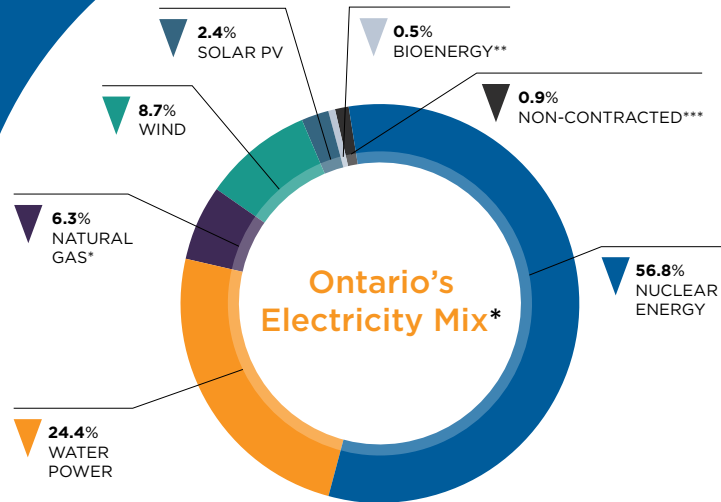
In Ontario, electricity supply comes from diverse sources. The system-wide supply mix is the combination of power sources used to generate the electricity consumed in Ontario.

As per Ontario Regulation 416/99, Hydro Ottawa is required to disclose this information to our customers annually. The below chart shows the supply mix data for 2020, which was published by the Ontario Energy Board (OEB) on March 22, 2021.
