## Why we're doing this


- Hydro Ottawa equipment located in this area is reaching end of life
- As a result, it is essential to replace the underground equipment to maintain the electricity capacity required to provide power to your community



## Overview

- Installation of concrete encased road crossings and 6,000m of buried ducts
- Removal and replacement of 46 transformers located on: Bernice Court, Buckskin Way, Fortune Drive, Jeanne D'Arc Boulevard, Long Bow Gate, Orleans Boulevard, Paddler Way, Snowshoe Crescent, St Dunstans Place, St Jovite Ridge, Saint-Emmanuel Terrace, St-Germain Crescent, St-Jérôme Crescent, St Louis Drive, Ste-Thérèse Lane and Vorlage Drive
- Excavation and replacement of underground cables located in this area
- Project timeline: August 2024 December 2025
- Total customers impacted: approximately **500 homes**







## **Benefits of taking proactive steps**

- **Improved reliability** of the system to prevent longer unplanned outages in future
- **Reduced impact** of equipment failure
- Limited effect of system issues
- Renewed aging assets across the community


